



2019 USTA North Carolina Junior Team Tennis Championships

Event Fact Sheet

- The 2019 USTA North Carolina Junior Team Tennis Championships consists of qualifying teams from the local leagues throughout the State. The tournament offers the following divisions:
 - Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced: 10 & Under, 12 & Under, 14 & Under, and 18 & Under
- The tournament date is July 12-14th and will be played in Wilmington, NC.
- Sites used for tournament play:

- Practice Courts Available

- Entertainment and activities will be provided throughout the weekend

- **10 & Under, 12& Under, 14& Under, and 18& Under Beginner, Intermediate, & Advanced Junior Team Tennis Track**
 - *Minimum number of players:* 3 players (non-gender specific)
 - *Format:* 1 singles and 1 doubles followed by 1 singles and 1 doubles
 - *Scoring:* Short sets to 6; no-ad; 7 point tiebreaker at 5 all
 - *Balls:* 10 & Under Beginner/Intermediate – orange ball
 - *Balls:* 10 Advanced, 12& Under Beginner/Intermediate- green ball
 - *Balls:* 12 & Under Advanced-18 & Under- yellow ball
 - All players must be registered in the TennisLink system and show a 2 team match history
 - Players 12-18 must be within the rating band if they have a rating.
 - Beginner: 0.0-2.7
 - Intermediate: 2.8-3.4
 - Advanced: 3.5 and above
 - No further advancement opportunities
- Teams will compete in a non-elimination round-robin. The tournament director reserves the right to change the tournament format if necessary due to the number of team's registered, inclement weather, and any other reason that would require such action.
- The winner of each flight/division will be determined by the total number of games won.
- In case of a tie between two or more teams at the conclusion of the round-robin, the tiebreak criteria will be the following:
 - If two teams are tied, head-to-head results.
 - If three or more teams are tied: the least number of sets lost, then the least number of games lost, then, finally, a spin of the racquet.
- Championship/Playoff Match Tiebreak – In the event that team scores are tied at the completion of a championship or playoff match, the teams will play a mixed doubles, 10-point match tiebreak to determine the winner of the overall match. Players for the mixed doubles may be selected when the tie occurs.
- **Registration**
 - All teams must register on TennisLink with the registration number given by their Local League Coordinator or State Coordinator. All teams must meet the

eligibility requirements (Please refer to National Regulations and Southern Regulations)

- Deadline: June 28th, 2019
- Coaches are required to turn in **ALL** required forms by July 3rd (all forms online through Jotform)
 - Forms required by July 3rd
 - Player roster (team form)
 - Coaches waiver
 - Player's combined consent form (This is a photo and medical release form)
 - Player's Party RSVP on WEBSITE
 - All parents and siblings must purchase tickets to the player party ahead of time or the price at the door will go up.
- Fees
 - \$25.00 per player
 - \$100.00 Team Deposit*
 - *Team deposit will not be processed unless in the event the team does not show up to the tournament after registering and/or withdraws from the tournament prior to completion of play.
