## **GRETA JUNIOR TEAM TENNIS MATCH FORMAT**

- There are 4 lines played per match: 2 singles and 2 doubles. A player may play 1 singles line and 1 doubles line per match. A player may also play both doubles lines per match. A player may not play both singles lines in a match.
- Each line plays a short set to 6 games, with no-ad scoring. For ad-point, the receiver may choose which side of the court to receive serve. A 7-point tiebreak will be played at 5-all. The traditional tiebreak method shall be used (not Coman), meaning players will switch sides of the court after every 6 points. JTT tiebreak scoring is win by 1 point (if the tiebreak score is 6-6, the next point wins).
- The match winner is determined by the total number of games won. In the event of a tie, the last court to finish shall play a 7-point tiebreak to determine the winner of the match.
- TennisLink is the official system for reporting scores. The Home team captain is responsible for entering scores within 48 hours of the match.
- A match may be played with as few as 3 players or as many as 6 players. For example, if only 3 players are available (A, B, & C), in Round 1 Player A could play singles while Players B & C play doubles. In Round 2, Player B or Player C could play singles while Player A plays doubles with the remaining player.
- Each player is required to play at least 2 different team matches during the season in order to advance to the JTT State Championship Tournament (Spring season only). Retirements count toward the 2-match minimum but defaults do not.
- Defaulting a court or match is highly discouraged. Please be as lenient as possible, within reason, about defaults, such as for tardiness. If a Coach/Manager knows ahead of time they will not have enough players for a match, the match or court may be rescheduled with the agreement of both Coaches/Managers. If a match or court is rescheduled, the JTT Coordinator must be informed prior to the regularly scheduled match.
- Players are responsible for their own water. Water is not provided by GRETA and may not be available at the facility.
- **Good sportsmanship should be practiced at all times, both on and off the court.**
