## DETERMINING WINNERS

Match Scoring: To win a team match, a team must win most of the individual courts played. If the match ends in a tie (i.e. 1 to 1 or 2 to 2 ), it will be broken as follows:

- The team with the fewest sets lost.
- The team with the fewest games lost.
- The team with the highest game winning percentage.
- Winner of \#1 Doubles


## DETERMINING LEAGUE STANDINGS

The league standings are determined by:

1. Team Wins
2. Individual Matches Won
3. Head-to-Head
4. Least Sets Lost
5. Least Games Lost

At end of season, if teams are tied for $1^{\text {st }}$ place:

1. Winner of the most individual matches (courts)
2. Winner of head-to-head match
3. Loser of fewest sets
4. Loser of fewest number of games
5. Toss of a coin
