DETERMINING WINNERS

Match Scoring: To win a team match, a team must win most of the individual courts played. If the match ends in a tie (i.e. 1 to 1 or 2 to 2), it will be broken as follows:

- The team with the fewest sets lost.
- The team with the fewest games lost.
- The team with the highest game winning percentage.
- Winner of #1 Doubles

DETERMINING LEAGUE STANDINGS

The league standings are determined by:

- 1. Team Wins
- 2. Individual Matches Won
- 3. Head-to-Head
- 4. Least Sets Lost
- 5. Least Games Lost

At end of season, if teams are tied for 1st place:

- 1. Winner of the most individual matches (courts)
- 2. Winner of head-to-head match
- 3. Loser of fewest sets
- 4. Loser of fewest number of games
- 5. Toss of a coin
